Local Rules

If a ball lies in the general area and an immovable obstruction (such as a sprinkler head) is within two club lengths of the green and within two club lengths of the ball, and intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief under Rule 16.1b (dropped within one club length of the nearest point of relief).

In the general area, tree wells surrounded entirely by grass are no play zones in ground under repair, even though unmarked. Relief is available under Rule 16.1. (dropped within one club length of the nearest point of relief from the tree well and any swing interference from the tree).

When a golf ball comes to rest in the desert within one scorecard length of desert/grass edge, free relief may be taken. Ball should be placed no nearer to the hole, 12 inches from the edge, in the desert.

Alternative to Stroke and Distance (Model Local Rule E-5) will be in effect.
