



SPEEDING POLICY

Effective July 17, 2017

Amended July 24, 2018

Speeding

All persons operating a vehicle in the community must obey all Arizona traffic codes and the posted speed limit. Mirabel’s speed limit is 25 MPH unless otherwise posted. Any person exceeding the posted speed limit is in violation of this guideline.

Penalties

Speeding Violations Reported 5 – 19 MPH over the posted speed limit:

| Second Violation | \$100 Fine |
| Third Violation | \$200 Fine |
| Fourth and Subsequent Offenses | \$300 Fine Per Occurrence |

Excessive Speeding Violations Reported 20 MPH over the posted speed limit:

| First Violation | \$300 Fine |
| Second Violation | \$400 Fine |
| Third and Subsequent Offenses | \$500 Fine Per Occurrence |

Please refer to the Property Owner Fine Policy for details regarding the notice and appeal process for monetary penalties.

Resident’s Guests/Visitors/Renters

If the violator is a **guest, visitor (including service providers) or renter** of a member or resident, the member or resident shall also be sent a copy of the violation, and may be penalized pursuant to the fine schedule above. If a fine is imposed, the member is responsible for payment. Renters are classified as guests of owners. If the guest/visitor requests an appeal, the member/resident is notified and must appear with the violator.

Members/Residents/Visitors (non-service providers)/Club Members/Renter

In assessing a penalty, if a violation occurs within six months of the driver’s previous violation it is considered a subsequent violation. If the violation occurs more than six months after the most recent violation it will be considered a first violation.

Vendors & Service Providers

In assessing a penalty, if a violation occurs within twelve months of the driver’s previous violation it is considered a subsequent violation. If the violation occurs more than twelve months after the most recent violation it will be considered a first violation.

Club Members

The Speeding Policy applies to everyone operating a vehicle in the community. For the purposes of this policy Mirabel Club Members are treated the same as Mirabel Community Association Members/Residents. Copies of any violations will be issued to the Mirabel Club.

Mirabel Club Employees

The Club will be notified of any employee violations.
